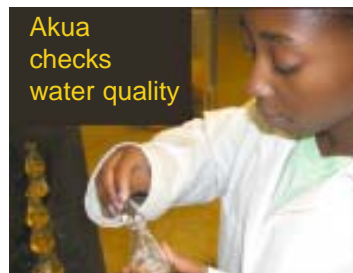
Things Are Jumpin' In Aquaculture
